#### Main Ideas

- Florida Natural Resources Leadership Institute (NRLI) is an Extension program focused on training professionals around the state in leadership development skills.
- In the Natural Resources industry, collaborative and interpersonal skills are vital.

  Natural resource conflicts often fall into this category.
